In the year gone by, we embraced that invitation across villages, towns, schools, and communities, carrying our shared mission forward — **preventing cancer, preserving futures**. Together, we touched **5,092 lives through 40 impactful events** under our five core projects: Femicare+, Shakthi, Karunai, Nila, and Shishya.

Through **Project Femicare+**, our cancer screening camps in Chennai neighbourhoods brought essential mammograms and pap smear tests to 217 women, breaking barriers of cost and access. **Project Shakthi** reached **4,255 beneficiaries**, from school children learning the hazards of tobacco to corporate employees and women’s groups empowered with knowledge on breast health, HPV vaccination, and preventive lifestyles.

With **Project Karunai**, we extended direct financial assistance to cancer patients and their families and stood by communities during Cyclone Michaung, bringing relief materials to 200 individuals. **Project Nila** championed menstrual hygiene and cervical cancer prevention, delivering HPV vaccines to **145 girls** and sanitary supplies to promote dignity and long-term health. **Project Shishya**, trained aspiring paramedical students from disadvantaged backgrounds, opening doors to livelihoods in healthcare.

These numbers, however, are not merely statistics — they are stories. A mother who can now face the future with courage after early detection. A student inspired to become a health worker. A patient whose pain was eased in their most vulnerable hours. Each outcome is a reflection of **your trust, your generosity, and your belief in this cause**.

Looking ahead, we are preparing for an even more ambitious chapter. Plans are underway for a **free, cancer screening centre** offering continuous quality care and cancer screening to marginalised communities. Our greenfield dream, the **Project Karunai Palliative Care Centre**, will bring world-class comfort and holistic care to those in life’s most delicate phase. We will also expand HPV vaccination drives, menstrual hygiene support, and paramedical training facilities — investing not just in treatment, but in prevention, education, and empowerment.

As I reflect on this journey, I’m reminded of the child whose life-saving heart surgery first inspired the Trust’s inception. That same spirit — that no one should be left behind because of poverty or lack of awareness — fuels us every single day.

About Us:

Kalpavriksham, is the brainchild of Dr. M. Banu Priya, who founded the trust in the year 2011 while studying for her third year MBBS degree, with nothing more than a few thousand rupees and the will to serve those in need. Her first brush with social work came while visiting the pediatric ward of her alma mater, Government Medical College, Thoothukudi as an undergraduate student. She encountered a three-year-old toddler with severe cardiac abnormalities and destitute parents who could not afford the child's treatment. Moved by their plight, Dr. Banupriya initiated a fundraising campaign within her hostel and undergraduate friends. The response to this initiative was overwhelming, she managed to raise enough funds for the child to get surgical treatment at a reputable charitable hospital and thanks to her efforts the child has grown to be a healthy teenager today. Inspired by the success of her campaign, she founded Kalpavriksham trust and adopted the motto "Join hands to save lives" as the trust's official slogan. True to the slogan, with the help of like-minded individuals she has gone about creating awareness and raising funds for social causes.

Over the years the trust has undertaken a number of activities; free medical camps have been conducted in various places ranging from Villivakkam, Chennai to Bodipalayam, Pollachi. These camps have served multitudes of poor people by providing them with free quality healthcare and medicines in their time of crisis. The trust also played a pivotal role during the calamitous flooding of Chennai city in the year 2015, free medical camps were conducted in Kotturpuram and Palavakkam, care packages comprising of essential household items were distributed in Saidapet and individual business owners who lost their livelihood were provided financial aid to stand up on their feet again. All these activities have earned our Trust a lot of goodwill among the common public and has motivated the founder and trustees to push forward on with their aim to serve.

The young undergraduate student is now an eminent Radiation Oncologist and double Gold Medalist from Cancer Institute, Adyar and MGR Medical University. Along with her, the trust has also evolved to focus on "Solving the cancer crisis". As an oncologist, Dr Banupriya believes strongly that cancer can be best tackled by prevention and early diagnosis. Today our activities span cancer prevention through free HPV vaccination; early diagnosis through free mammogram, pap smear; training underprivileged girls in paramedical courses free of cost; cancer treatment at an affordable cost and palliative care.


Vision Statement:

True to its motto, this project is geared towards being more and more women above the age of 40 into the ambit of screening for breast cancer. The driving force of this project is data which states that screening mammograms can reduce female mortality due to breast cancer by 30%. The awareness about mammogram and it's availability is low in our country. Among those who are aware many are intimidated by the cost of mammograms. We are working with partners to take mammograms right to doorstep of these women at an affordable cost and we are encouraging people to sponsor mammograms for the less fortunate women. Over time we hope to operate a bus of our own and conduct camps on a bimonthly basis in semi urban and rural areas.

FDG PETCT SCAN WHOLE BODY

Clinical History / Data:

- Known case of carcinoma right lung.
- CT Chest (24.02.2023) - Features suggest possibility of carcinoma right lung with nodal metastasis - Staging T4N3MX. Central vein obstruction - Involving SVC brachiocephalic vein and lower IJV. Intra-atrial tumour thrombus noted in right atrium. Pericardial effusion and bilateral pleural effusion.
- HPE from lung mass (01.03.2023) - Suspicious atypical cells in inflammatory background.
- PETCT (09.03.2023) - Features are suggestive of malignant neoplastic lesion in the anterior mediastinum / right lung with mediastinal lymphnodal spread, pericardial involvement, cervical and abdominal lymphnodal metastases.
- Post 3 cycles of chemotherapy and 21# of radiotherapy status.






