



Her parents, unable to afford treatment, stood in silent agony. I was just a medical student, armed with clinical knowledge but no resources. And yet, the strength of compassion, the power of collective will, and the belief in humanity led me to rally a few friends. Together, we raised funds to gift her the life she deserved. Today, that child is a thriving teenager, and that day remains the cornerstone of what eventually became **Kalpavriksham Trust**.

Since its inception in 2011, Kalpavriksham has grown from a dream to a living, breathing movement. With our motto “Join hands to save lives,” we have spent over a decade walking alongside the underserved and unseen—providing healthcare, creating awareness, empowering women, and most importantly, reminding every individual that they matter.

The financial year 2024–25 has been one of profound impact, and this report is not merely a collection of activities; it is a testimony to countless lives touched and futures preserved.

### **Cancer Prevention—Our Foundational Pillar**

At Kalpavriksham, we believe that early detection saves lives. With this belief, **Project FEMICARE+** continued its mission to bring mammograms and Pap smears directly to women’s doorsteps—through homes, schools, workplaces, and remote villages. We hosted **34 screening camps**, reaching nearly **2,000 beneficiaries**, and conducted over **1,000 Pap smears and 900+ mammograms**. Whether in bustling Chennai or the silent corners of Arni and Pollachi, women came forth with curiosity and courage—choosing awareness over fear.

What warmed our hearts most were the women who returned, bringing their sisters, neighbours, and mothers. Health, we realized, spreads like hope.

### **Awareness Is Empowerment**

**Project SHAKTHI** transformed silent concern into loud action. With **40 awareness events and more than 5,000 attendees**, we reached communities that had never heard of HPV vaccines or self-breast examinations. From drawing competitions at Korukkupet to Zoom webinars with corporate professionals, from training community health workers to addressing schoolgirls with shining eyes—we tailored each session to the people in front of us, ensuring no message was lost in translation. These numbers are gratifying, but the real triumph lies in the hundreds of women who walked in with doubt and walked out with resolve.

## Protecting the Young—Project NILA

If cervical cancer is preventable, why let it steal lives? **Project NILA** focused on schoolgirls and college students—educating them on menstrual hygiene and offering **HPV vaccination** drives. In collaboration with dedicated partners like **Sevalaya, Ethiraj College, and Rotary Club of Chennai**, we reached over **3,000 young minds**, distributed over **21,000 sanitary pads**, and administered **255 HPV vaccines**. The smile of a 13-year-old after receiving her first dose of protection is more than reassurance—it's a generational shift.

## Building Skills, Restoring Dignity

This year marked the launch of **Project SHISHYA**, along with **Pearl Health Institute**, a sanctuary for underprivileged young women to pursue paramedical courses—with no fees, no capitation, and full support for food and stay. With just **four girls enrolled initially**, this is not a number we see as small—but as the first wave of many. These girls aren't just students—they are future caregivers, breadwinners, and ambassadors of change.

## Strength in Survival

No report is complete without acknowledging the indomitable spirits we met through our cancer support group, **இதுவும் கடந்து போகும் (This Too Shall Pass)**. In our inaugural event, **Dr. D. Venkateshwaran**, Sri Lanka's Deputy High Commissioner, graced the occasion, joined by survivors, caregivers, artists, and healthcare professionals.

From nail art and reflexology to art therapy and inspirational talks, our goal was simple—restore joy. Remind every survivor that healing is possible not just medically, but emotionally. Across two events, we welcomed **105 survivors**, and we plan to make this a regular fixture in the coming year.

## Looking Forward

As I sit back and absorb the magnitude of these efforts, I am humbled—not just by what we have accomplished but by what remains to be done. We envision a **permanent free cancer hospital**, open all days, offering **routine screenings, cancer treatment, palliative care**, and a safe space for the marginalized.

We hope to expand FEMICARE+ with a dedicated mobile mammography unit, multiply SHAKTHI sessions in rural belts, scale NILA vaccinations with government partners, and enrol more students in SHISHYA with residential facilities.

And, in everything we do, we remain committed to the values that founded us: **Compassion, Equity, Empowerment, and Service.**

## Gratitude and Call to Action

To our CSR partners like **Five Star Business Finance Ltd**, the incredible team at **Privaram Cancer Hospital**, volunteers, educators, donors, and the local community—you are the wind beneath our wings. To every individual who liked our post, shared our video, spoke about us in boardrooms or dinner tables—you've helped save lives without even knowing it.

To everyone reading this today—join hands with us. You can donate, volunteer, or simply spread awareness. You can be the difference between fear and courage, ignorance and hope, illness and healing.

Kalpavriksham is more than a trust. It is a movement. A tree that continues to grow, whose branches shelter, whose roots strengthen communities. Let us continue this journey—toward a future where no child suffers untreated, no woman feels unseen, and no life is lost to lack of awareness.

**About Us:**

Kalpavriksham, is the brainchild of Dr. M. Banu Priya, who founded the trust in the year 2011 while studying for her third year MBBS degree, with nothing more than a few thousand rupees and the will to serve those in need. Her first brush with social work came while visiting the pediatric ward of her alma mater, Government Medical College, Thoothukudi as an undergraduate student. She encountered a three-year-old toddler with severe cardiac abnormalities and destitute parents who could not afford the child's treatment. Moved by their plight, Dr. Banupriya initiated a fundraising campaign within her hostel and undergraduate friends. The response to this initiative was overwhelming, she managed to raise enough funds for the child to get surgical treatment at a reputable charitable hospital and thanks to her efforts the child has grown to be a healthy teenager today. Inspired by the success of her campaign, she founded Kalpavriksham trust and adopted the motto "Join hands to save lives" as the trust's official slogan. True to the slogan, with the help of like-minded individuals she has gone about creating awareness and raising funds for social causes.

Over the years the trust has undertaken a number of activities; free medical camps have been conducted in various places ranging from Villivakkam, Chennai to Bodipalayam, Pollachi. These camps have served multitudes of poor people by providing them with free quality healthcare and medicines in their time of crisis. The trust also played a pivotal role during the calamitous flooding of Chennai city in the year 2015, free medical camps were conducted in Kotturpuram and Palavakkam, care packages comprising of essential household items were distributed in Saidapet and individual business owners who lost their livelihood were provided financial aid to stand up on their feet again. All these activities have earned our Trust a lot of goodwill among the common public and has motivated the founder and trustees to push forward on with their aim to serve.

The young undergraduate student is now an eminent Radiation Oncologist and double Gold Medalist from Cancer Institute, Adyar and MGR Medical University. Along with her, the trust has also evolved to focus on "Solving the cancer crisis". As an oncologist, Dr Banupriya believes strongly that cancer can be best tackled by prevention and early diagnosis. Today our activities span cancer prevention through free HPV vaccination; early diagnosis through free mammogram, pap smear; training underprivileged girls in paramedical courses free of cost; cancer treatment at an affordable cost and palliative care.

To conduct free cancer screening, cancer prevention vaccination and medical camps, create awareness about cancer. To provide financial aid for medical, educational and occupational needs of underprivileged individuals.
